Lithuanian PE Association (1993)

Lucas/Casper NORTH- not much to report

Elinor/Susan CENTRAL-Knowledge Exchange CPD.

- Future plan suggested for a possible Online CPD workshop in the autumn IPPEA, SATPE and possibly Lux, NW Counties associations.
- A second teacher virtual exchange between SATPE and IPPEA planned
- Need to check email addresses of Central EUPEA members
- Chris gave a Local Report from his Regional; professional training for teachers; issues- shortage of PE expertise at primary level; courses Primary expert degree; time for PE (Secondary; 2 hours but generally 1) Primary is 2 hours compulsory; 3-5 years old 3 hours; other issues Outdoor and Adv activities... 'risk assessments' is too time consuming therefore implications for OAA.
- Claude Lux- a new organisation being created - Primary Association- first meeting a few weeks ago. Next meeting middle of June. Claude is supporting them in building up association. Hope to have a new EUPEA member from this organisation at the Zeist meeting. **Implication for IPPEA invite to IPPEA conference and Central Europe virtual workshop in the autumn**
- Marcus Portugal challenged the division between Primary and Secondary associations

Viviana/Marcus **SOUTH**-Italy news: European School Sport Day April 2018 40 participants attended recent meeting in Budapest;

Marcus reported formal PE assessment reinstated in Portugal as an exam mark in final school year.

SOUTH EAST Yiannis Reported the challenges attempting to seek news from Greek EUPEA members. Emails sent but no responses; Cyprus have only engaged in the past.

Yiannis made a presentation to the EUPEA Board on the Greece: Olympic Spirit Day with the purpose of the organisation seeking EUPEA approval for this historic sports event.

- Olympic Education Day 6th April; Olympics Education separate to Olympic Games which has problems!
- Raises the question National Olympic Associations implications for PE???? Olympism in schools???? (Irish links with PE?? No academy here). Interesting the lack of consistency in countries.
- Olympic Council of Ireland v National Academies
- Maybe the ESSD takes this Olympic spirit as a theme some year
- Should EUPEA endorse The Olympic Education Day in Greece? Need a follow up with a memorandum of understanding.
