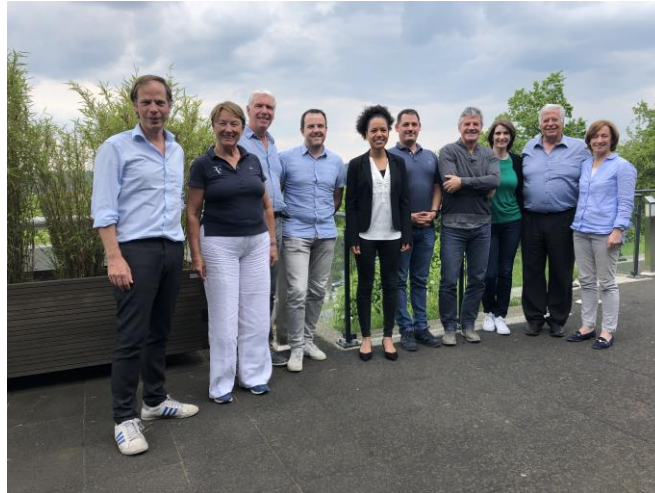

Friday 24th May

EUPEA Questionnaire Project, which began in autumn 2018, was progressed and led by Susan Subcommittee Susan, Rosemary, Martin and Elinor

Focus- ***Who is teaching PE in primary PE in Europe?***

- Prepared and piloted in May/June 2019
- Live September 2019
- Research Question: Who is teaching primary Physical Education in Europe?
- Who completes the questionnaire? The person who is responsible for the teaching/delivering Physical Education in the primary school?
- Target Groups Teachers teaching PE (Generalists, Specialists and Coaches)
- Preliminary descriptive results shared at EUPEA Forum October 2019 by Susan

EUPEA Central Europe Regional Report/Update

- Susan, the vice representative, reported on Central Europe EUPEA work. (Elinor Steele the Central representative was not arriving until Friday afternoon). Susan reported outcomes of the *Pledges* made by the teachers and IPPEA committee members who attended the IPPEA Blended Advocacy in PE workshop in January 2019.
- Susan and Elinor to consider further blended Advocacy workshop and get more subject associations committee members on board from Central Europe who will then have regional/school advocacy workshops and pledge outcomes
- Susan is proposing to deliver an Advocacy workshop to IPPEA committee members and they disseminate at further regional workshops.

Susan gave an update on IPPEA news: new IPPEA committee chair; She highlighted:

- the Workshop at IPPEA conference on *Cooperative Sports Day with an ESSD focus*. Progress on the Redevelopment of Curriculum update and where PE is at and the IPPEA advocacy document freeze. She mentioned the significant appointment of Prof Mary O Sullivan as Chairperson of the NCCA and the Minister for Educations launch of PE and Gaeilge initiative in which there will be 40 pilot schools targeted.
- Claude confirmed the formal formation of the Luxembourg Primary PE association called *Movement Association*. The IPPEA should consider linkages.

Presentation

School Sport 2020 - by Teresa Odipo, German Sport University Cologne Sport University Cologne

(Research on Physical Education funded by the German Ministry for over 1 million euros)

- While School Sport is the umbrella term used for the study research Physical Education was and is a key element in the research funded by the German government (3 areas of examination in the research were motivation of teachers and student teachers teaching PE, Wellbeing and stress of teachers and student teachers on PE and Heterogeneity (differences))
- 3-year project
- Now at phase 4- Dissemination
- Project orientated work results (training course, film dates and appointments)
- Theory and Practical day sessions for teachers and Publications were outputs of the study
- Final year student thesis linked to the study
- Results highlighted that the most stressful aspects of teachers work to the curriculum, equipment, subject status and behavioural problems.
- Research has received further funding School Sport 2030
